

“Major Full Scale Exercise BINTUNI” at KLSM Tokyo office

A Major full-scale exercise was conducted to validate the structure and interface, in order to identify opportunities to provide support for improving the capabilities to provide support for a significant incident. The exercise core objective was to test the integrated communication between Tangguh Time Chartered vessel, Ship owner, Tangguh LNG Sales Operation & Shipping Team Exercise involved reporting to P&I, Japan Coast Guard, Classification ABS, Marine Salvage, Oil Spill Response Company, Hospital, Media and Next of Kin.



Scenario involved M/V Iron Voyager small tanker en route to Singapore collides with fully loaded LNG tanker “Tangguh Foja” off the coast of Okinawa during heavy weather condition. Both vessels were reportedly damaged as result from the incident and oil spilled from the tanks of both vessels. Tangguh Foja’s one crewmember was injured, who required medical evacuation.

KLSM Emergency Response Team and “Tangguh Foja” Emergency Response Team demonstrated individual and integrated functional roles, responsibilities and capabilities while mitigating the major incident. Each player involved in the exercise was asked to submit the players evaluation after the exercise was concluded. The goal of the exercise was to identify areas for continued improvement of the crisis management capabilities.
